## Vagabond Opera Concert Preview – Triple Door – Seattle

Based out of Portland, Oregon, Vagabond Opera is like nothing found on the television or radio.

Claiming a unique sound all their own, Vagabond Opera blends European cabaret, vintage Americana, Balkan belly dance, neo-classical opera and old world Yiddish theatre into a well-rounded Bohemian cabaret. The six-piece band brings together old and new with exotic mixes of Paris hot jazz and tango to Ukrainian folk-punk and klezmer. There really isn't a single genre or word to describe them.

The group consists of trained operatic tenor and soprano vocals, accordion, tenor saxophone, cello, stand-up bass and drums as well as 13 languages being used throughout the songs, an edgy stage presence and an overall new take on the often traditional and sometimes stuffy world of opera.

Vagabond Opera comes to Seattle again with The Triple Door's rating of "returning favorite" and "recommended." Appearing at The Triple Door, Vagabond Opera will play on Saturday, July 18 at 8pm for all ages. Tickets are \$18 advance or \$20 day of the show. The doors open at 6pm.

Listed across genres as wide as Americana, cabaret, gypsy, jazz, opera, pop, ragtime and world, Vagabond Opera might just be the most accessible band for all listeners.
